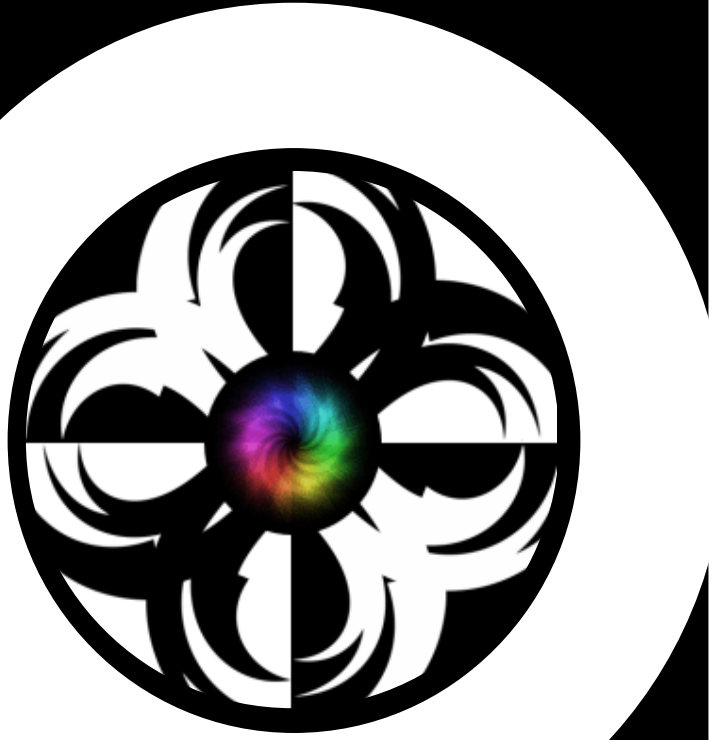
TAKE PART IN A STUDY ON AUTHENTICITY AND RELATIONSHIP SATISFACTION
